Individual rights for clients:

Clients are involved in decisions about care, treatment, and services provided.

Clients receive adequate information about the person responsible for the delivery of their care, treatment, and services.

Clients have the right to refuse care, treatment, and services in accordance with the law and regulation.

Clients have the right to a second opinion regarding diagnosis and treatment.

The client's confidentiality, privacy, and security are respected.

Clients have the right to be free from mental, physical, sexual, and verbal abuse, neglect, and exploitation.

Clients have the right to pain management.

Clients have a right to care with or without advance directives.

My medical information may be used for consultation, billing or claims payment or other purposes as I may direct.
